- **Tie Breaks-** Trophy winners determined (a) sum of progressive scores(b) sum of opponents scores. Tie breaks for cash prizes announced at start of tournament.
- Players must either be direct members of the Association or bona fide members of clubs that are affiliated to the Association.
- Depending on entries, all players may be in the same section . In that case Accelerated Swiss pairing will be used to reduce the incidence of games between players of greatly differing strengths in the early rounds.
- Light refreshments(tea, coffee and biscuits)will be available.
- **Car parking** -Fee paying car park in front of building. Free on Sunday.
