BOURNE END ONE-DAY CHESS CONGRESS (George Parker Memorial) Sunday 24th March 2024

One-day five-round rapid play tournament for players of all strengths.

The Congress will be divided into sections of between 12 and 20 players of a similar playing strength (based on current ratings).

The top section is likely to be for players with ratings of 1900 or above, whilst the lowest section would be players rated under 1500.
